Executive Board Reports - Adjudication

- 2018 Accomplishments
 - Judge development for local judges
 - Shirley Dorritie (TCGC Director of Education and WGI Director of Education) conducted training. Held in early December at The Woodlands College Park High School.
 - Required for all members of Judges Association.
 - Local judges were also required to participate in judge training session at the first contest of the season. Consisted of completing commentary files and numbers. Dialogue with working panel throughout the day.
 - Analysis of previous weeks' scoring ranges provided to working panel each week.
 - Weekly directives provided to working panel by Judges Association Board.
 - Panels completed and provided to TCGC Board well in advance of the December 15 agreement.
 - Early season shows were WGI panels. Remaining shows were mixed panels - WGI and local judges.
 - Championships panel (double) - mix of WGI and local judges (50/50 split)



Executive Board Reports - Adjudication

- 2018 Judge Feedback Overview
 - Feedback provided to judges throughout the season.
 - Formal concerns reported to Judges Board = 2.
 - All concerns were addressed/resolved prior to judges' next scheduled contest.
 - Concerns were addressed by Greg Llacer (Chief Judge)
 - Judges removed from rotation.

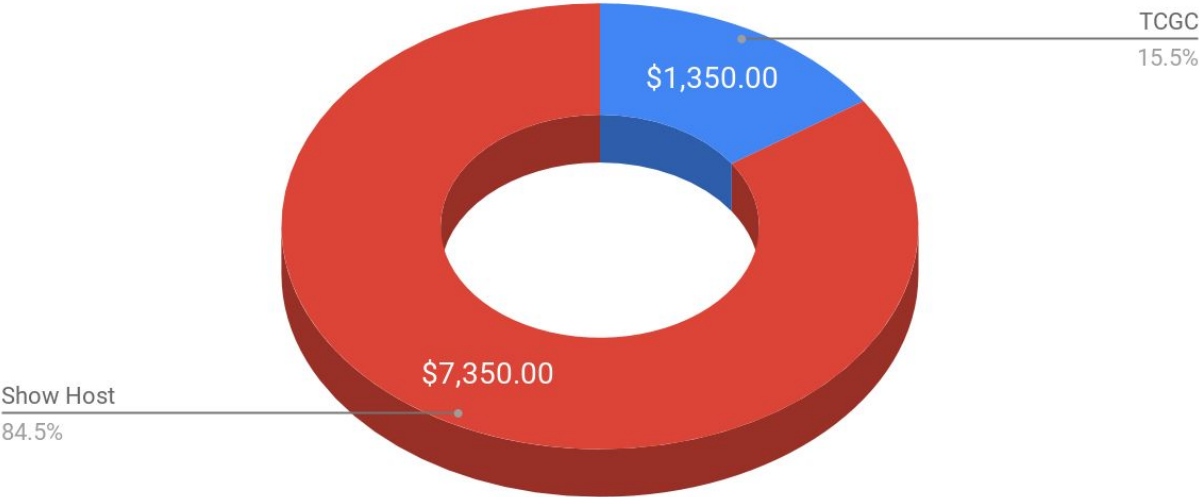

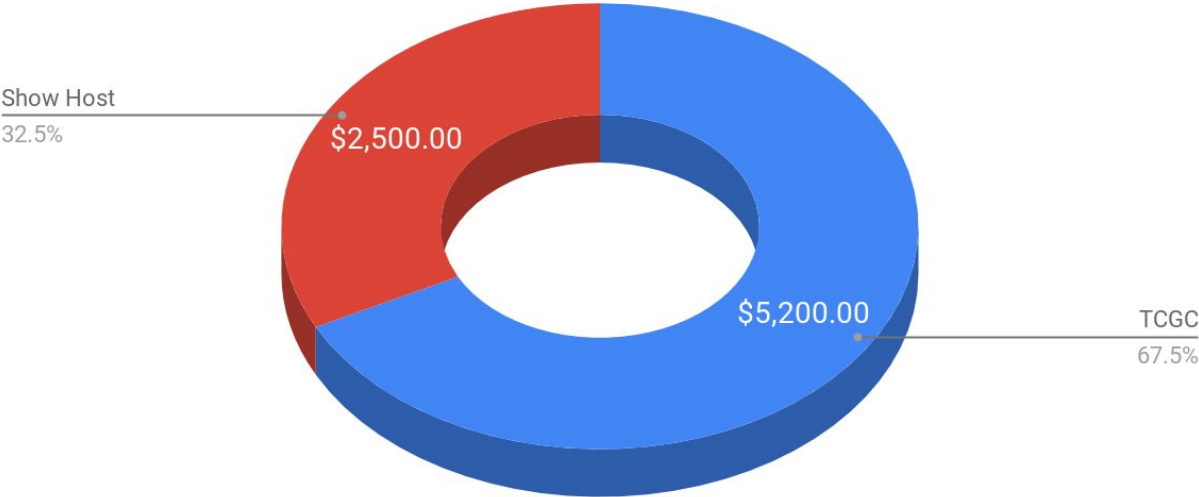
How we used to fund shows

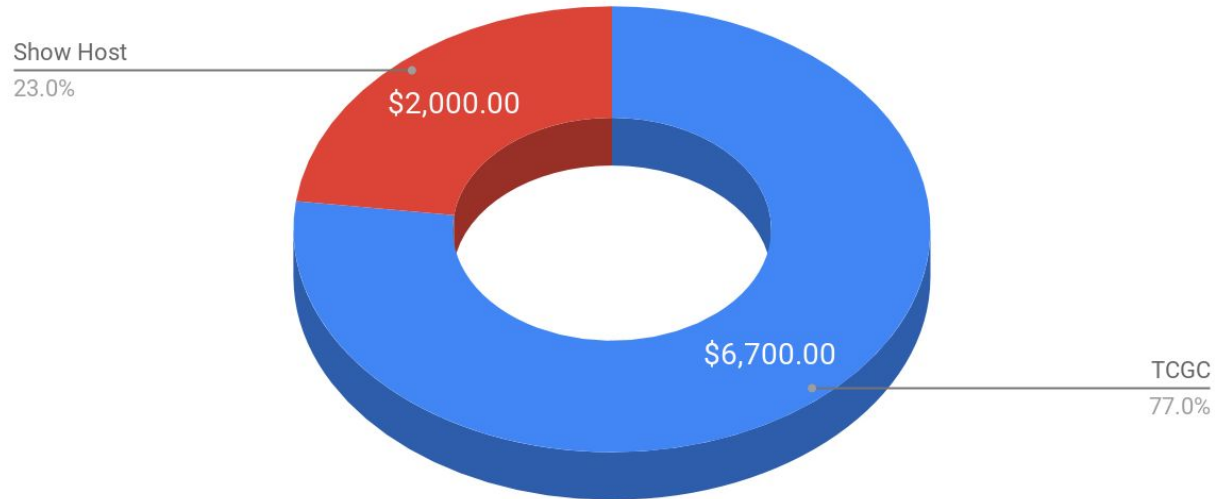
How we currently fund shows

New Business

- **By-Laws Proposal**
 - Article IV, Section 7: Voting Rights
 - **Current By-Law:** Each member is entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote by the members. Voting at duly held meetings shall be held by voice vote. Election of the Officers of the Board, however, shall be by ballot or acclamation.
 - **Proposed Change:** Each parent organization is entitled to one vote on each matter submitted to a vote by the members. Voting at duly held meetings shall be held by voice or electronic vote. Election of the Officers of the Board, however, shall be by written or electronic ballot or acclamation.



New Business

- **By-Laws Proposal**

- Article V
- **Current By-Law:** Sections 1, 2, and 8
- **Proposed Change:** SECTION 1. NUMBER OF OFFICERS

The Board of Directors of the Texas Color Guard Circuit shall consist of the following offices: President, Color Guard Vice President, Percussion Vice President, Educational Programming Vice President, Adjudication Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. No office may be held by more than one individual and no such individual shall hold more than one office at any time. These officers shall be referred to as the Executive Board.

SECTION 2. QUALIFICATION, ELECTION, AND TERM OF OFFICE

...The offices of President, Educational Programming Vice President, Adjudication Vice President, and Secretary will be elected on even numbered years at the Spring meeting. The offices of Color Guard Vice President, Percussion Vice President, and Treasurer will be elected on odd numbered years at the Spring meeting.

SECTION 8. DUTIES OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING VICE PRESIDENT

The Educational Programming Vice President will work to promote the Texas Color Guard Circuit within the state of Texas by growing the educational offerings for performers, directors, and adjudicators (in collaboration with the Judge's Association). These opportunities will include performer workshops, director education for new and experienced directors, webinars, and new judge recruitment and training. The EP VP will also seek new opportunities to collaborate with other entities to promote growth within TCGC.
